predict that Congress will pass an anti-piracy law soon

*Form:


Sub + will + v (base) + C.

Examples:

1. I don't think he'll come tonight.

2. I predict that Congress **will pass** an anti-piracy law soon.

3. If you ask him, he'll probably **give** you a lift.



*Negative form:

Sub + will not + v(base) +C.

Remember: will not= won't.

Examples:

1.It won't be rainy tomorrow.

2. They will not come next week.

3.I hope you won't leave me.

4.I think she won't pay with cash.
