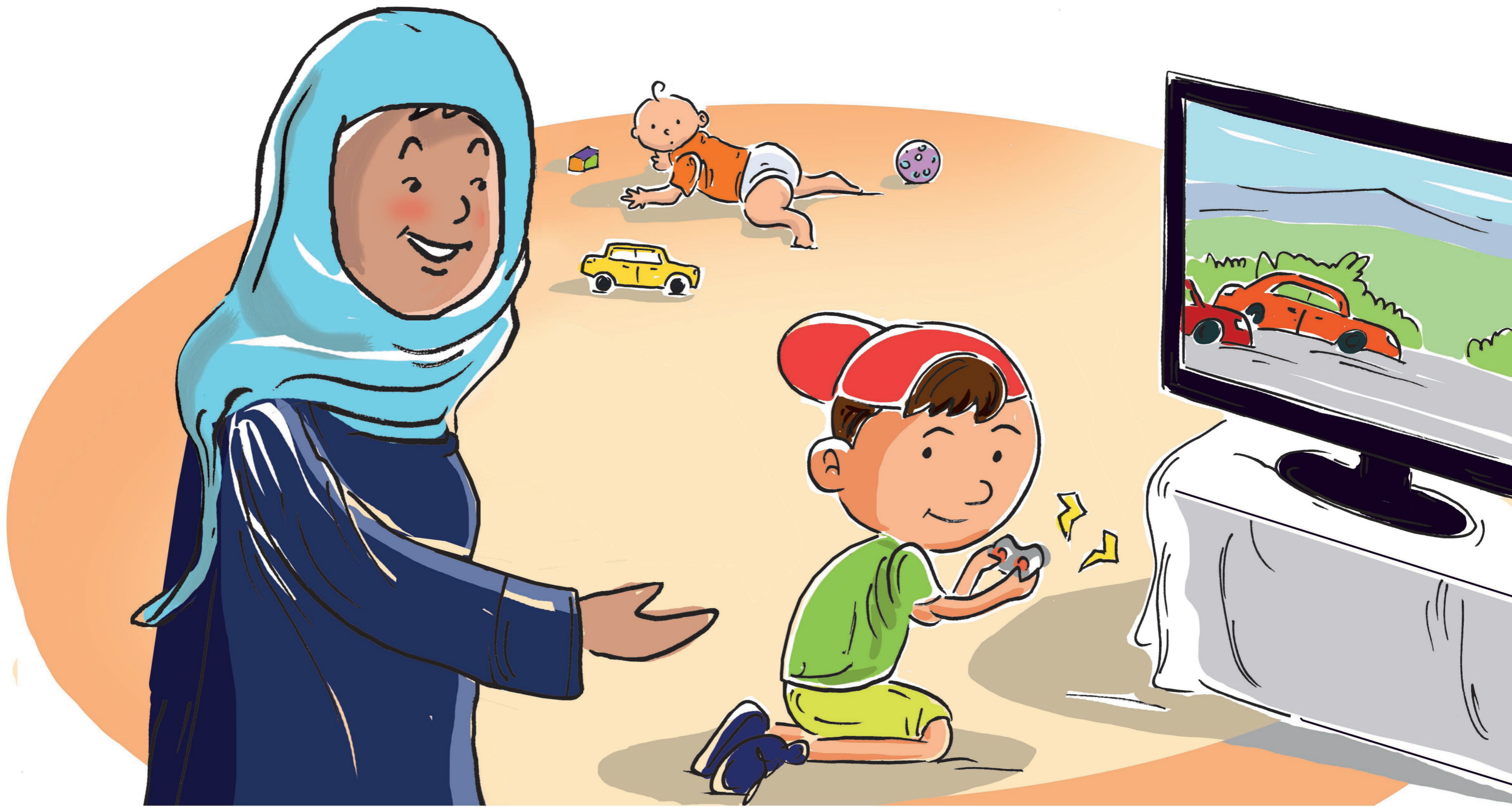




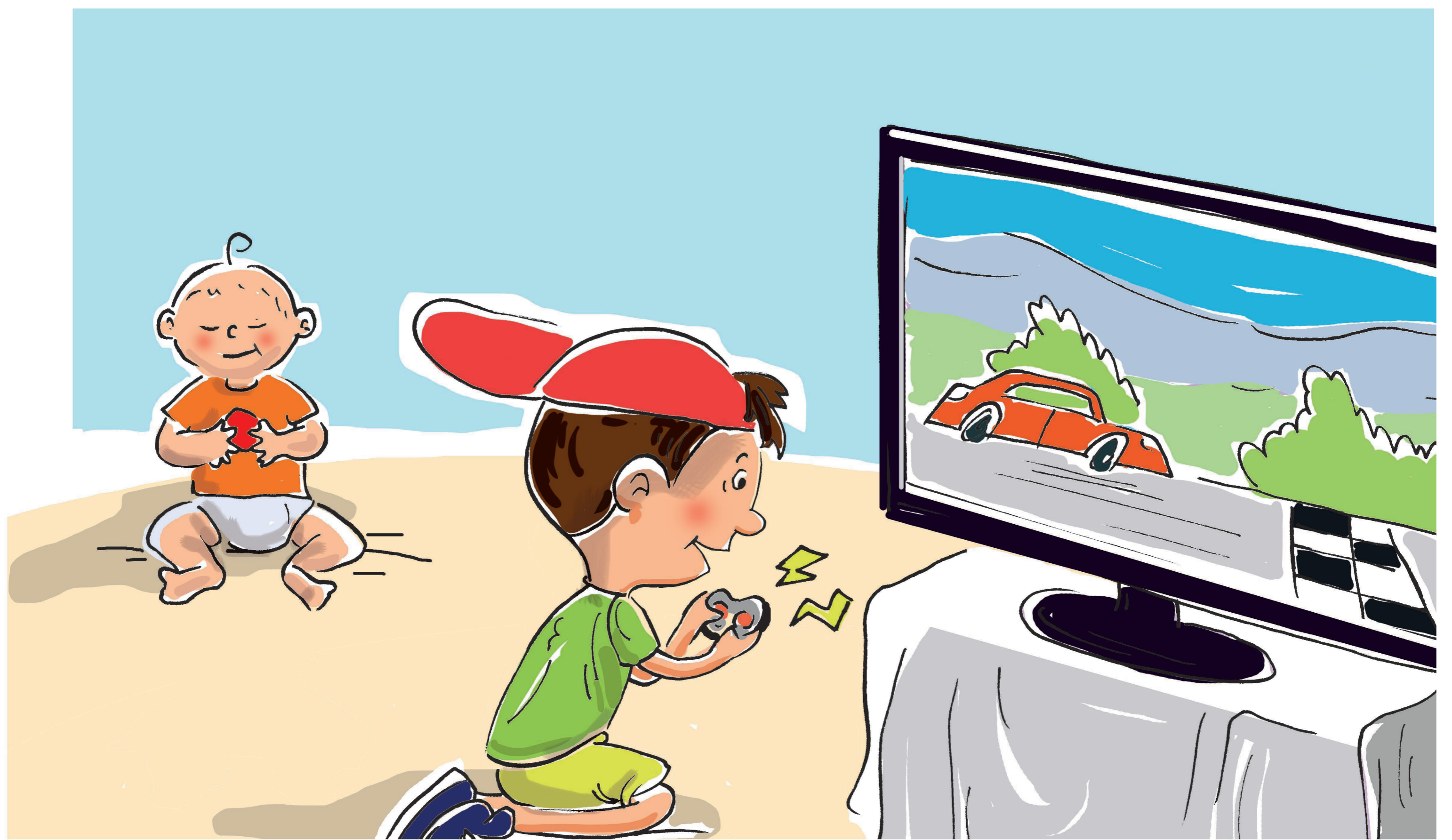
Ahmed has a little brother.

'Ahmed, can you look after your brother please?' mum asks.



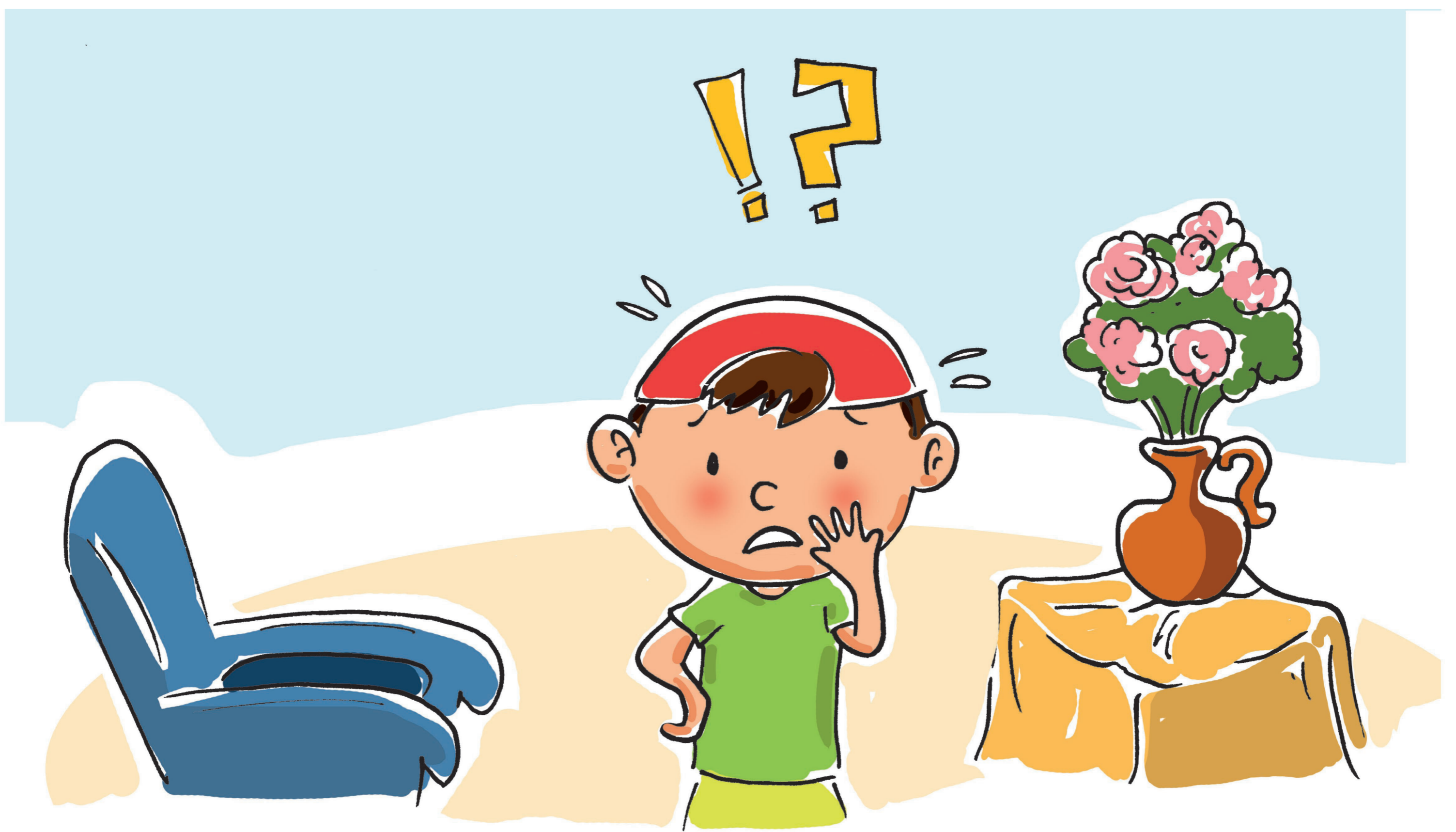
'Yes, I can,' says Ahmed.



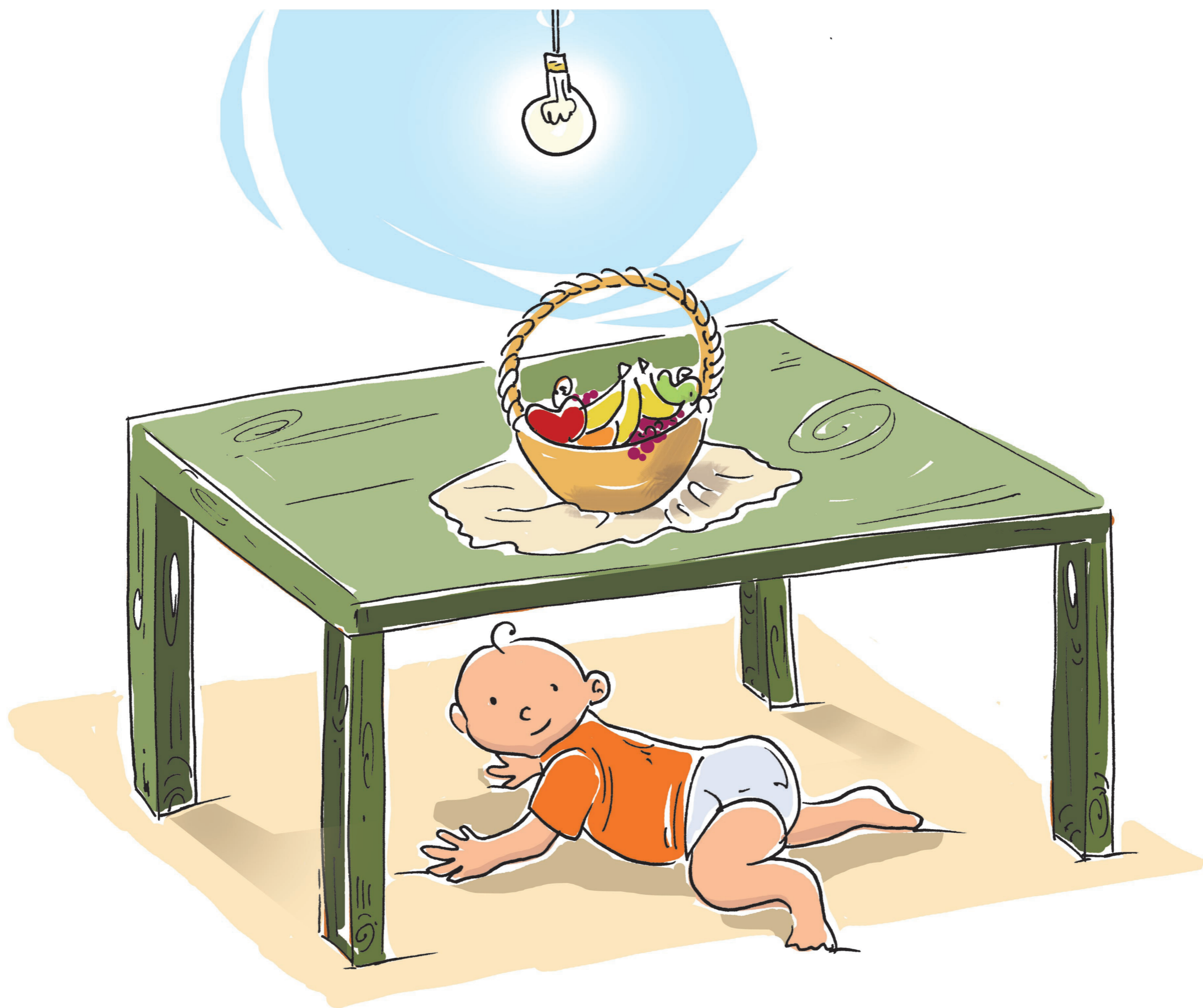

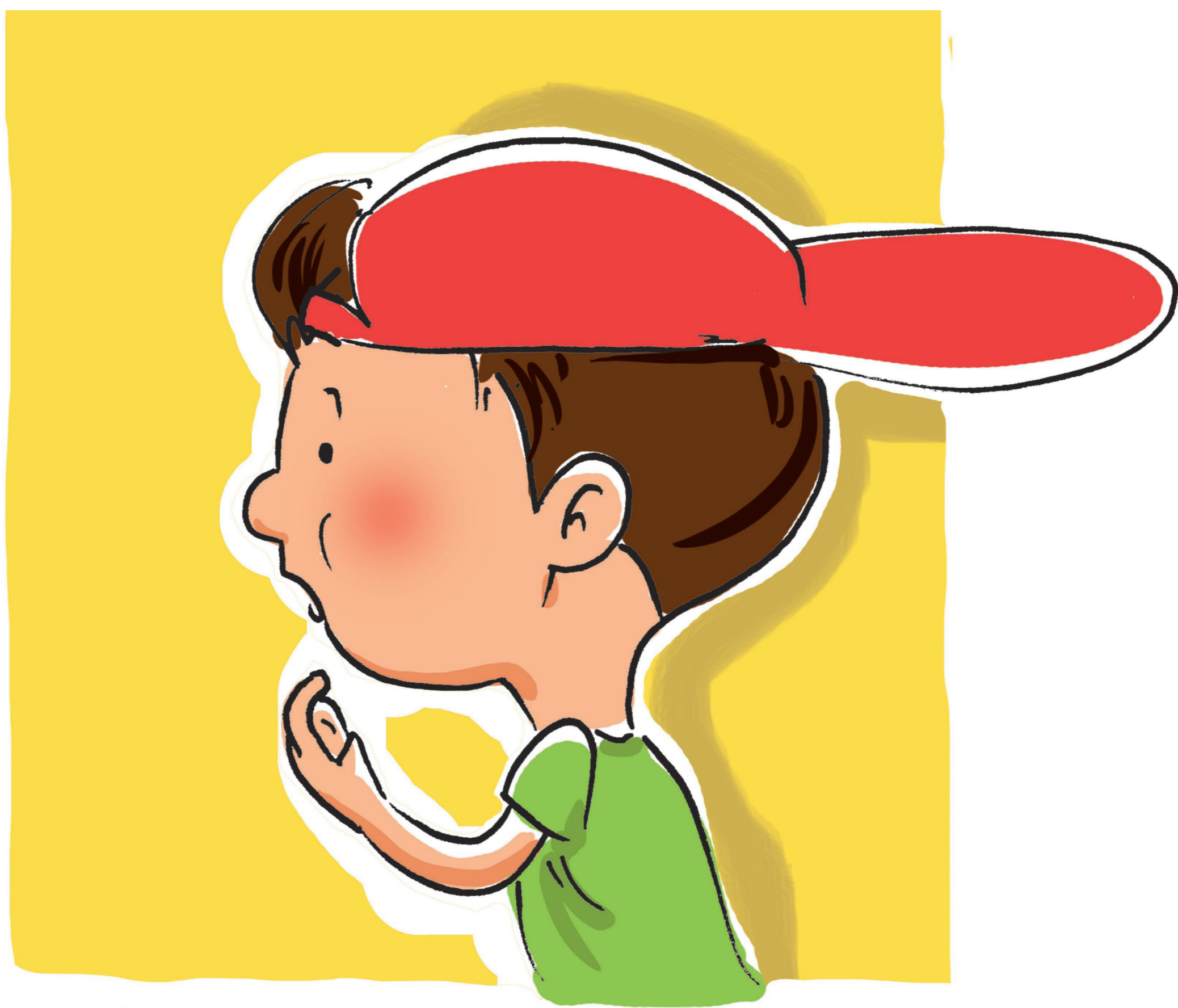

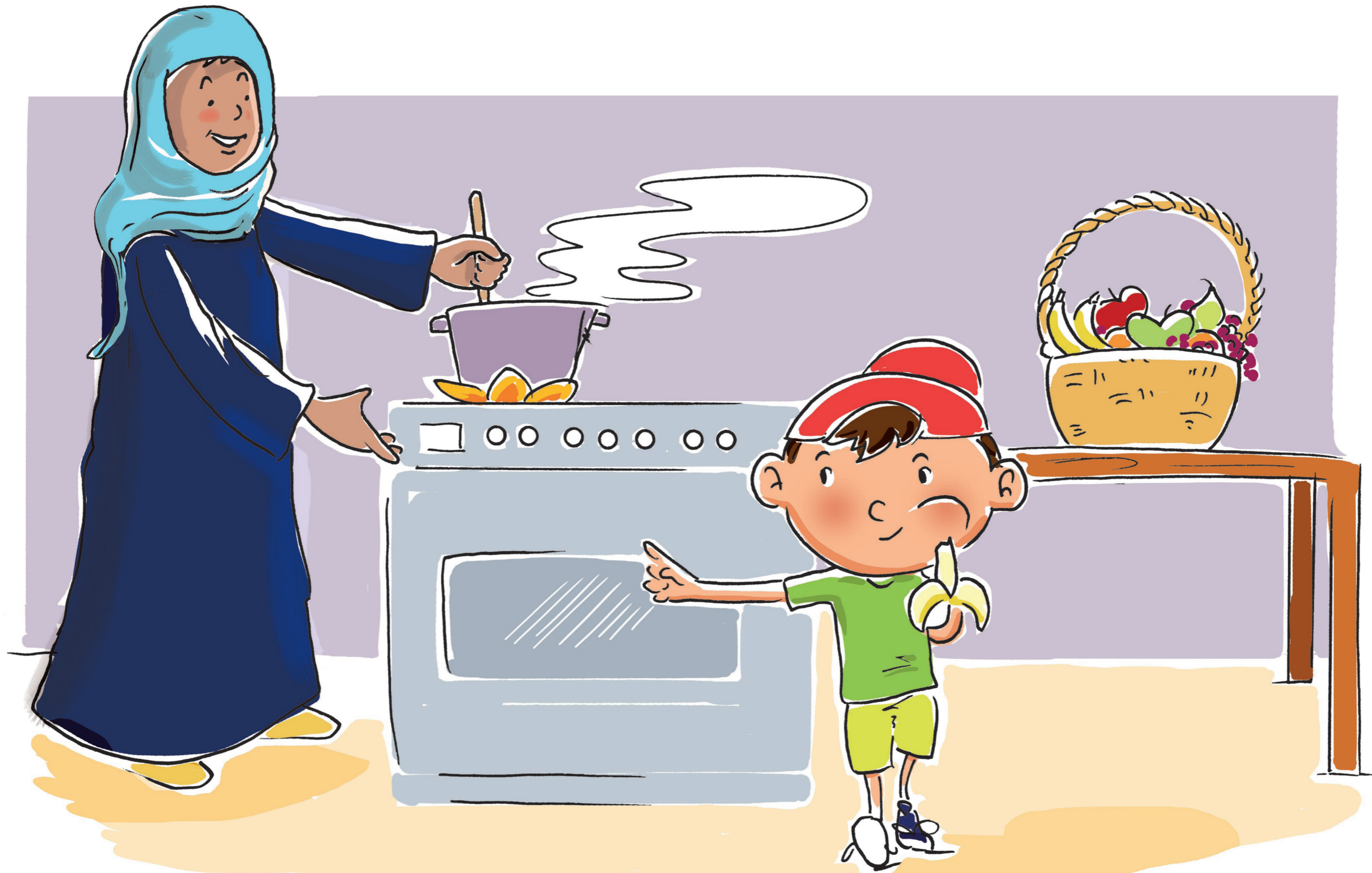
