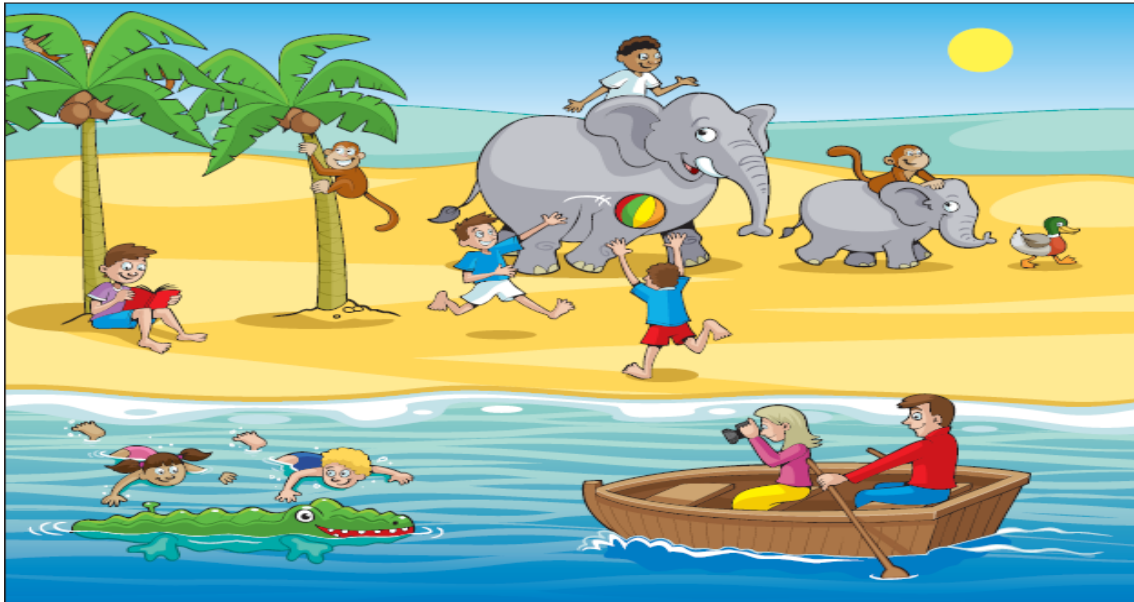
PART TWO

Speaking Test

Time: 2 minutes for each student

SPEAKING 1 (1 minute for each student)

(5 marks)



1. The teacher familiarizes the student with the picture first and then asks the student to point out certain items on the scene picture, e.g., ‘Where’s the monkey/girl?’
2. The teacher asks questions about two of the people or things in the picture, e.g. ‘What’s this?’ (Answer: An elephant) ‘What colour is it?’ (Answer: grey)
- 4-How many monkeys/elephants/boys are there in the picture?
- 3- ‘What’s this?’ Point to the duck/ boy with purple T-shirt/ ball.

SPEAKING 2 (1 minute for each student)

(5 marks)

The teacher asks questions about the student, e.g. ‘How old are you?’

2. What do you like/don’t like to eat?
3. What can/can’t you do?
4. How many bedrooms are there in your house?
