From 1921 to 1925, he attended Yale University and studied English literature. In 1924, he played in the Olympic Games in Paris and won the Olympic gold medal in rowing.

In 1925, he attended the medical school at Yale before moving to 'Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons'. In 1943, while he was on a summer vacation, he started writing his most famous book 'Baby and Child Care'.

From 1944 to 1946, he worked as a medical officer in the navy. At the same time, he continued to work on his book. The book was published in 1946. Over the years, the book was translated into many languages and became one of the all-time best-sellers. In 1968, he was awarded as the 'Humanist of the Year' by the 'American Humanist Association'. He died on March 15, 1998, at his home in La Jolla, California.
