

- Irregular verbs are common verbs in the English language that do not follow the simple system of adding "d" or "ed" to the end of the word to form the past tense
- 2. We use the first form of the verb to talk about something happening in the present time. We use the second form of the verb to talk about something that happened in the past. We use the third form of the verb to form a past perfect tense, and the past perfect tense refers to a time earlier than before now, It is used to make it clear that one event happened before another in the past.
