1	Adventure(adj)	An unusual, exciting, and possibly dangerous activity, such as a trip or experience, or the excitement produced by such an activity. Ex: My father loves adventure. .....
2	Afraid of (adj)	Ex: She is afraid of spiders. .....
3	Bored (adj)	Not interesting Ex: I was bored from the movie. .....
4	Bungee-Jumping(n)	The sport of jumping off a very high bridge or similar structure.. .....
5	Camel-Trekking(n)	The activity of walking long distances. Ex: Most of Emirati people love camel-Trekking. .....
6	Excited (adj)	Interested. Ex: I was so excited to visit my grandparents. .....
7	Interested in (adj)	Take care. Ex: I am interested in reading books. .....
8	Museum (n)	A building where objects of historical, scientific, or artistic interest are kept. Ex: There are a lot of museums in UAE. .....
9	Rock-climbing(n)	Climb the rocks .....
10	Skiing (n)	The activity which you play it on ice. Ex: My brother loves skiing. .....
11	Snorkelling(n)	The activity of swimming while using a snorkel Ex: My little sister prefers snorkelling. .....

12	Strange(adj)	Unusual and unexpected, or difficult to understand. Ex: There was a strange situation happened to me. .....
13	Surfing (n)	The sport of riding on a wave on a special board. Ex: My best friend plays surfing. .....
14	Surprised by(adj)	Feeling or showing surprise because something has happened that you did not expect. Ex: I am surprised by my marks in the exam. .....
15	Theme park(n)	A large permanent area for public entertainment, with entertaining activities. .....
16	Wildlife park(n)	A park for some animals. Ex: Last year, I went to a wildlife park in a school trip. .....
17	Snowboarding(n)	The activity or sport of moving over snow using a snowboard. Ex: I like playing snowboarding in my free time. .....
